In celebration of the 20th birthday of Omnifest, all five films included in the 2019 festival are Science Museum of Minnesota original productions.

Ring of Fire: 10 a.m. (Sat. & Sun. only), 3 p.m. & 8 p.m. (Thu.-Sat. only)

Tornado Alley: 11 a.m. (Sat. & Sun. only), 4 & 9 p.m. (Thu.-Sat. only)

The Greatest Places: Noon (Sat. & Sun. only) & 5 p.m.

Journey to Space: 1 p.m. & 6 p.m. (Thu.-Sat. only)

National Parks Adventure: 2 & 7 p.m. (Thu.-Sat. only)

Note: The Science Museum of Minnesota and Omnitheater is closed on Mondays (excluding January 21 and February 18).
